ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

In a bid to better understand the maintenance, long term traceability and calibration of Meteorological instruments Users of meteorological observations have increasing needs for high quality Meteorological and hydrological data. The traceability of these data to the International System of Units (SI) standards is needed to ensure their quality and to meet the users' Requirements. The course focuses on the latest science of measurement, siting of Meteorological instruments, care and maintenance of basic and automatic meteorological Instruments, calibration of meteorological instruments, troubleshooting (default detection) in Instruments, and drawing specification for weather instruments and measurement systems. The course will address ground based instruments and instruments on-board satellites. Lessons Learned from already on-orbit meteorological satellites and new generation satellites from around the world will be introduced and discussed.

THE AIM OF THE CONFERENCE

The course aims to bring together researchers, developers, policy makers, development Practitioners, climate scientists, user groups, stakeholders and institutions from Africa and the rest of the world to impart their knowledge and share experiences with others who are anxious to learn. The course will provide a forum for education and knowledge transfer.

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

This course will provide participants with the knowledge and practical skills in the latest science of measurement as well as on the maintenance and calibration of meteorological instruments. Participants are expected to master skills of using conventional meteorological instruments. They will be enabled to measure meteorological elements, understand and operate the routine observation, calibrate the conventional meteorological instruments, and execute the operation of Automatic Weather Station, etc.
